Campus for Jewish Life's FREE Memorial Day outing to feature fun activities, entertainment and food

East Brunswick, New Jersey - - May 12, 2009 - Good fun, good entertainment, good food and good friends will be the order of the day when The Campus for Jewish Life hosts its second annual Central Jersey Jewish Family Fun Day on Memorial Day, Monday, May 25. The day of activities is a free event sponsored by the local Jewish community and will showcase the East Brunswick campus at 75 Dutch Road.

The Campus for Jewish Life, formerly the YM-YWHA of Raritan Valley, has enjoyed a 70-year run as a centerpiece of the Middlesex County Jewish Community. Since closing its facility in Highland Park in 2006, The Campus has been hard at work, rebranding the organization and planning a new building at its East Brunswick site.

The Memorial Day event is a collaborative effort of all three of East Brunswick's synagogues (East Brunswick Jewish Center, Temple B'nai Shalom and Young Israel of East Brunswick) and is also sponsored by the Jewish Federation of Middlesex County and Hadassah and co-sponsored by all the area synagogues, the local Chabad centers, Torah Links of East Brunswick and the Chavurat Kol Haneshama. With a scheduled time from noon to 6 p.m., the day will feature music from NY Entertainment and Odessa, a Klezmer band. Other activities will include face painters, a moon bounce, a drum circle and Israeli dance demonstrations. Kiosks to purchase food and ice cream will also be available.

The Campus for Jewish Life's Y Country Day Camp has been serving children for over a decade and doubles as a swim club. The swim club covers 10.5 acres of the Dutch Road campus with tennis and basketball courts, softball fields, and two in-ground pools. Membership for the summer is free for camp families and \$250 for all others.

The Dutch Road location is also the future home of the Campus's Jewish Community Center to be called The Pavilion.

"Naming the facility 'The Pavilion' demonstrates that we are open and welcoming to all," says Amanda Shechter, The Campus's President. "In these difficult times we feel it is especially important to have a place for the entire community to gather."
